These are Junior Versions of the above talks, while many of these talks may seem to be too "high brow" for Junior High, they actually aren't and the Jr Highers actually are motivated by them and are stimulated to engage. These talks are broken down into bite sized chunks and are much more interactive than the adult versions. Most of these talks were refined through almost 8 years of Junior High ministry.
